## SUMMARY AND CAREER INTERESTS:

Gregory is the current Ontario High School Sprint and Intermediate Hurdle High School Champion and holds the Ontario Records in these events. This summer Gregory won the Ontario Outdoor Championships in the intermediate hurdles establishing a new Ontario Record. Gregory also won the Under 17 Canadian Championship in both the 110m and 400m hurdles as a first year Youth athlete. In the Canadian Junior Championship, Gregory won the Bronze Medal in the 110m hurdle final. Gregory was also a member of the 4X100 Canadian Junior Championship Gold Medal Relay Team and won 2 Gold Medals as part of Team Ontario at the Canadian Youth (17 and Under) Championship in the 4X100 and 4X400 Relays. Gregory competes in Football, Basketball, and Track & Field at Mother Teresa. He was grade 9 and 10 male MVP for Track and Field. Also the Jr. Football Offensive MVP along with Jr. Basketball MVP.

Gregory attends Mother Teresa Catholic Secondary School (London, ON) where he has maintained an 82 average. Gregory hopes to study Law and Athlete Management in University.
